

2 STAY AWHILE

Hacienda Nicholas, a bed-and-breakfast near the city center, caters to eco-minded travelers by using environmentally safe cleaning products and smart amenities: Expect organic bath product dispensers rather than a kajillion mini toiletries. (From \$110 per night; haciendanicholas.com)

s RAISING THE SALAD BAR

Most of the organic produce served at Vinaigrette is grown on owner Erin Wade's farm 20 minutes outside the city—and it's dished up within a few hours of harvest. The restaurant's greens-focused menu is always evolving and touts plenty of seasonal goodies. (vinaigretteonline.com)

4 ALL'S WELL

Body Cafe offers an all-organic menu brimming with raw, vegan and vegetarian options. The Asian-leaning eatery is part of a wellness complex that includes a yoga studio, fair-trade boutique and earth-friendly spa.
