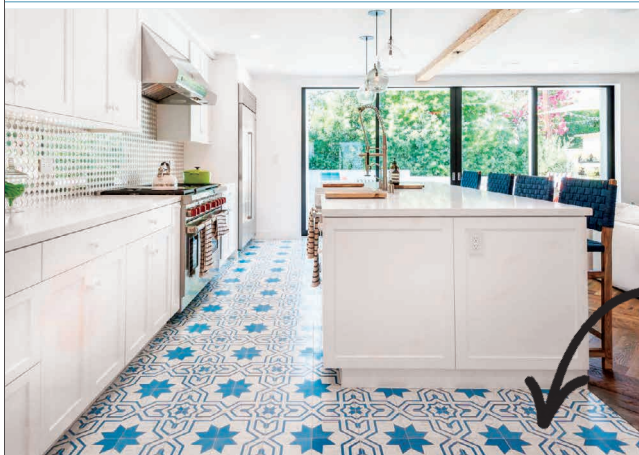
Landing the *Game of Thrones* star's custom L.A. home would take nearly \$2 million. But you can afford to copy her eclectic look

BOLD STRIPES AND LANDSCAPING

The Brit, 43, covers vibrant orange seats with black and white towels (try Pottery Barn's reversible awning version, \$40-\$50, potterybarn.com). Rows of greenery (Gronomic cedar planter, \$300, williams-sonoma.com) provide functional decor.

PATTERN PLAY

Add visual interest in a bedroom by contrasting two or three different motifs. Linens and accent pieces, such as The Pillow Collection's Garrick Geometric throw cushions (18x18-inch, \$60, wayfair.com) offer a low-commitment way to experiment.



GLOBALLY INSPIRED TILE

A modern white kitchen gets a jolt of personality and color thanks to a blue and white geometric floor. The Clunker Alcazar Petunia pattern from SomerTile (\$80 for 7.04 square feet, overstock.com) draws on a Spanish aesthetic to achieve a similar look.



A STATEMENT LIGHT FIXTURE

Bringing in a '60s-esque chandelier with polished brass, crystal flourishes and Edison globe bulbs balances out the living room's rustic touches and acts as a focal point. Savoy House's Galea Sputnik model channels the same vintage feel (\$478, lampsplus.com).
